Rules & Regulations:

- Any entries incurring bank fees will be charged \$50.00 plus cost of the bank fee and the original bill.
- Refunds will be made upon receipt of a vet certificate (or Dr.) & must be received by show manager before end of show. Office fee is not refundable.
- Every Class recognized by NEHC & MHA will be conducted and judged under the current rules.
- ASAM, MHA, NEHC & ASHA membership applications will be available at the Show Office. You may join the day of the show and receive points.
- Six (6) ribbons awarded per class. Prize Money as indicated: \$50 - \$20, 15, 10, 5. Trophies in all other classes. All vouchers are the responsibility of the winner when given. They must be turned in after your last class. ASAM accepts no responsibility for lost vouchers/premiums. Vouchers are null & void once show office has closed.
- Water and light snacks will be available for purchase.
- The ASAM Inc. Show Committee, MHA or their agents or employees, and/or the Hollis Equestrian Park will not be responsible for any accident which may occur to rider, groom, attendant, spectator, animal, or equipment at the show. Nor will any of the aforementioned be held responsible for loss or destruction of any property or equipment or damage to or by animals at the Show or on the grounds.
- **WARNING:** Under Maine State Law an equine professional has limited liability for an injury or death resulting from the inherent risks of any equine activities.
- Entry into additional classes must be made a minimum of 3 classes prior to the entered class.
- No dogs on the show grounds unless kept on a leash away from the ring.
- No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the show grounds.
- PROOF of current rabies, negative Coggins, vaccination records (Rhino, influenza, EEE, WEE, etc) and registration papers (breed classes) will be required to show.
- To be eligible for its respective Championship class, the entry must have been entered, shown and judged in the class in parentheses ().

Directions to the Hollis Equestrian Park:

From the South via the Maine Turnpike:

Take Exit 25 (formerly Exit 3) in Kennebunk. Follow signs to Route 35 North. Stay on Route 35 through Kennebunk and Lyman. Turn left on Route 5 North in Dayton. Park is 2.5 miles on left.

From the North via the Maine Turnpike:

Take Exit 46 (formerly Exit 7B) in South Portland. Turn left out of the toll booth and then left onto Route 22 West. Take Route 22 through Westbrook, Scarborough, Gorham and into Buxton. Turn left on Route 202 South into Hollis Center. Turn left, heading South, on Route 35. Turn right on Clark's Mills Road. At the end of Clark's Mills road, turn left on Route 5. Park is immediately on your right.

From Route 202 (Sanford area):

Turn right, heading South, on Route 5 in North Waterboro. Continue right on Route 5 toward Saco. Park will be on your right, approx 1 mile from where Route 5 and Route 202 part.
