Show Rules:

1. All classes recognized by Maine Horse Association will be conducted and judged under the current rules of MHA.
2. All classes recognized by Maine Hunter/Jumper Association will be conducted and judged under the current rules of MeHJA.
3. No horse/pony may enter a class unless an entry blank has been completed, fees paid, and number assigned.
4. Entry fees are as follows: \$15 per regular classes, \$20 per stakes, medal, and classic classes. MHA fee \$4 per horse/pony, un-judged warm-up \$10 per round, and \$5 post entry fee per horse/pony and rider. Entries close 7/31/2016.
5. Food will be available on the grounds. Lunch break, if any, will be announced.
6. No refunds without note from veterinarian or medical doctor.
7. No dogs allowed on premises unless leashed and kept away from the ring.
8. In each hunter division, to be eligible for its Stake class, entry must have been entered shown and judged in its respective 'over fences' class. For Championship classes, entry must have been entered, shown and judged in the class listed in parentheses.
9. Show ring/course will be an enclosed field. A schooling area will be available outside of the course.
10. Warm-ups will be held after class 11 and class 25. warm ups are 1 round per ticket. Jumping order will be used and one horse may be in the ring per time.
11. A schooling area with jumps will be provided from 7:00am through the end of the show. Course walks are allowed between 7:15 and 8:00.
12. Six ribbons per class will be awarded.
13. Medal specifications will be available at the secretary's booth.
14. Championship and Reserve Championship ribbons will be awarded based on points (no entry fee) in respective divisions. Divisions considered are Easy Does It, Schooling Hunter, Special Working Hunter, Children's Working Hunter, Thoroughbred Hunter, and Low Working Hunter.
15. Proof of current negative coggins and rabies vaccination required. Mail in with entry or bring to secretary's stand.
16. Cross country courses and jumps are closed to all horses. Dressage arena is open for lunging.
