Every class recognized by the Maine Horse Association will be conducted and judged under the rules of the Maine Horse Association, Inc.

All Morgan Classes will be conducted and judged in accordance with AMHA specifications as outlined in the current USEF Rule Book. In addition to the 'Open' class of each MORGAN division, subsections will be held as needed to facilitate OKC qualification. Please request any needed classes on your entry blank with your pre-entry. Championships will be held as needed. To be eligible, horse or rider must have been entered, shown and judged in its respective section.

Entries close August 6 and will be accepted after that date with a **post entry** fee of \$15 for each horse or pony. No horse may enter its class until an entry blank has been completed, sighed, fees paid & number assigned. The management reserves the right to decline any entry & return any entry fees prior to the opening of the show without being liable for compensation. Any entries incurring **bank fees** will be charged \$50 plus the cost of the bank fee plus the original bill

Proof of current Rabies, Negative Coggins (within 3 years for in state horses and 1 year for other) vaccination records (Rhino, Influenza, EEE, WEE etc.) and registration for breed classes will be required.

All post entries, adds or scratches must be made at least 4 classes ahead at the secretary's office.

Refunds: There will be no refunds on entry fees unless due to a bona fide injury of horse, exhibitor or exhibitor's family. Request for refund must be received by the Show Manager before the end of the show for consideration. NO EXCEPTIONS <u>Office fee is not refundable</u>.

Awards: Six ribbons and a trophy will be awarded in each class. Championship classes will receive either a trophy or cash if so designated. *Money will be given in the ring in cash and will not be replaced*.NO EXCEPTIONS Prize money will be awarded to 4 places. <u>TOTAL PRIZE MONEY OF \$300</u> \$75 is divided 1st \$40, 2nd \$20, 3rd \$10 4th \$5 No **dogs** on the grounds. No alcoholic beverages on the show grounds.

Holds at the discretion of the Show Manager only. Two minute gate call will be enforced.

Food will be available on the grounds.

Attire: Proper show attire for MHA Show Academy attire for academy classes held during lunch break. Directions: Take the Maine Turnpike to Exit 63 (formerly Exit 11) in Gray, Maine.Bear to the right after the toll booth, toward the center of Gray Village. Stay in the right lane. At the first intersection, go straight through the light onto Route 115. Continue on Route 115 (East) for 1.6 miles, then turn left onto Depot Road.Continue on Depot Road for 2.8 miles to a stop sign.Turn left at the stop sign onto Route 231/Intervale Road, Pineland Farms Equestrian Center is 1545 Intervale Rd., New Gloucester, ME 04260

Maine Morgan Horse Club retains the right to change or add officials if necessary Approved ASTM/SEI properly fitted and fastened headgear IS REQUIRED for ALL junior hunter seat riders in ALL classes at ALL shows with the exception of junior Morgan Hunter Pleasure riders. Helmets are strongly encouraged for any rider anywhere on the show grounds.

To be eligible for its respective championship, the horse (or rider) must have been entered, shown and judged in the class listed in brackets [].

 SPORT HORSE IN HAND, OPEN To be shown standing in the open position and then at a walk and trot on the lead with one handler. Quality movement is a priority in the Sport Horse classes. The traditional way of showing the open position would be with the right front leg slightly back and the right hind leg slightly forward; as long as all four legs of the horse are visible to the judge when standing on either side of the horse, would be allowed to show in a natural and comfortable carriage, and the handler should stand away from the horse with a loose lead line
- 5. **\$75 Open In Hand Championship** Must have entered, shown and been judged in one other class in this division.

WALK & TROT / GREEN HORSE

- 9. Green or Junior Horse Walk/Trot or Jog Pleasure Open *To be shown at a walk and trot/jog/alternate gait both ways of the ring. To be shown with a light rein but still maintaining contact with the horse's mouth. To be judged on performance and apparent ability to give a good pleasure ride with emphasis on manners and gait 60%; type and conformation 40%.*
