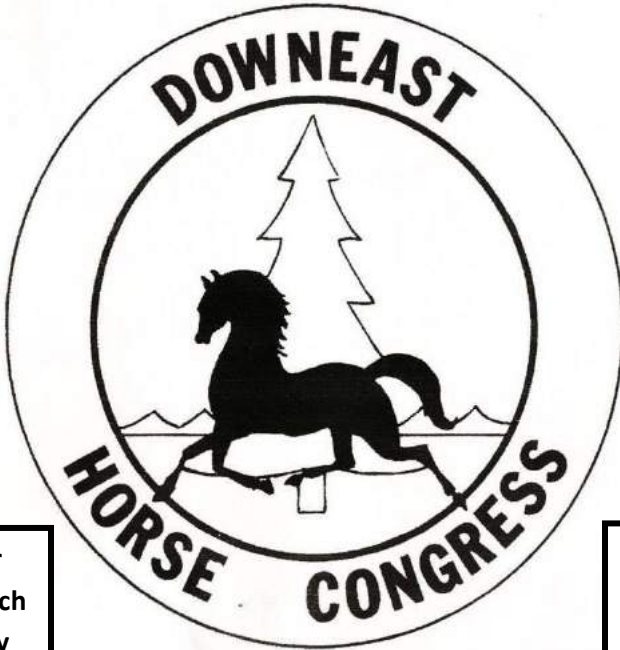

GENERAL RULES/INFORMATION **2022 DOWNEAST HORSE CONGRESS**

Exhibitors are expected to read these rules and not enter any horse/pony unless they are prepared to abide by these rules, the rules of MHA, NEHC, affiliated associations and this show. Show management reserves the right to refuse any entry or request the removal of any entry or person on the grounds without being liable.

Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules & Specifications of the current Rule Books of MHA, NEHC, MeHJA, USHJA & ECCRA will be conducted & judged in accordance with those rules. All classes MHA pointed UNLESS Noted.

Additional Payment Information:

- All fees must be paid in full (or a signed blank check left with the office to pay for all charges) before number is issued.
 - \$50.00 fee will be charged for NSF checks in addition to bank fees & original charge.
 - **Refunds** for classes will only be considered upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate (or doctor's certificate) and must be received by the Show Manager before the end of the show.
No refunds on Stalls or campers.

CREENTIALS - Including this information with your entries will greatly facilitate check in & number pick-up! 😊

- Vaccinations.** Please include a copy of vaccination records for your horse(s) with your entries. It is highly recommended that **all animals** on the show grounds be vaccinated for **RABIES** within one year of this show.
- Proof of Negative Coggins** within the last three years is required for horses stabled in the State of Maine and within the last six months is required for out of state horses. Please include Coggins date (month/year) on your entry blank.
- Adult Riders** in classes **restricted to Amateurs** must have a valid amateur card from USEF, NEHC or MHA available for inspection. MHA and NEHC Amateur cards may be applied for at the Show.
- Registration Papers** are required for entries in classes restricted to a registered breed. Please include registration number(s) on your entry blank and include a copy of the papers with your entry form. **Saddlebred exhibitors** MUST also provide their ASHA membership numbers for owner, rider, driver & handler.
- USHJA Outreach** – To be eligible for USHJA Outreach points and year-end awards, riders must be a USHJA member (Outreach level or higher). Horses wishing to accrue points toward year-end Outreach awards must be registered with USHJA and microchipped. USHJA Horse registrations are available for \$20/annual or \$75/lifetime.

General Information:

1. **Adds/Scratches** for the **Coliseum** **MUST** be made during the previous session.
2. **Hunter Ring Adds/Scratches** may be made at the Hunter Ring. When you settle up at the end of the show at the Main Office, please be sure that the paperwork for adds/scratches has been delivered to the Main Office.
3. **Entries for Friday night** **MUST** be made by 5:00 pm. Your compliance helps the show start promptly and is greatly appreciated. **Holds** by permission of Show Management only. Forms are available in the office.
4. **Food** will be available on the grounds.
5. **Length of Breaks** will be announced.
6. Six ribbons in all classes. Prize Money indicated in class title with trophy in all other classes.
7. **Prize Money** will be directly credited to your show bill. Checks for award money will be issued only after show bill has been paid in full.
8. **Prize Money** distributed as follows:
 \$75 – \$25, \$15, \$10, \$10, \$10, \$5; first through sixth, respectively
9. Arena lights will be turned off at 10:00 pm or after the show
10. **For everyone's safety** ~~
 No **strollers** in the chute area and near the in/out gate.
 All **dogs** must be tied or on a leash & kept away from the show ring rail.
 Lunging and long lining are NOT allowed in the coliseum.
 Bicycles & scooters allowed only in the camping area behind last barn.
 Fire & Emergency lanes must be kept open at all times
11. Any person entering the ring while the show is in progress must be properly attired. No short-shorts/skirts, tank tops, torn/worn clothing. Items with stable logos are not permitted.
12. Exhibitors wishing to speak to the judge after their last class must obtain permission of the Manager and Steward & will be allowed only if it does not delay the show.
13. **WARNING Under Maine Law an equine professional has limited liability for an injury or death resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.**
14. All Championship/Stake classes: To be eligible, respective horse/rider must have been entered, shown and judged in at least one class listed in parenthesis in the Classes by Division section.
15. **ALL JUNIOR EXHIBITOR Hunter Seat Riders at PLEASURE SHOWS/RINGS** as well as in the **Hunter Ring** are required to wear ASTM/SEI approved protective properly fastened headgear when mounted (Exception: Juniors in Morgan Hunter Pleasure). Riders of ALL seats are encouraged to wear ASTM/SEI approved headgear and shall not be penalized for doing so.

14. ALL HUNTER/JUMPING SEAT EQUITATION AND HUNTER PLEASURE EQUITATION RIDERS, REGARDLESS OF AGE, IN ALL SHOWS ARE REQUIRED to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. This INCLUDES Equitation Classes open to ALL seats. **ANY RIDER violating headgear rules** at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with such standards.

Classes by Division

DOWNEAST REQUEST A COLISEUM CLASS

Is a class you'd like missing from our pleasure show? Do you need a class to help you qualify for year-end awards? Downeast will accommodate your needs for a \$25 per class sponsorship donation. (Regular class fees also apply). Please notify Regan Grant (reganwgrant@gmail.com) on or before Saturday, June 4. This will give her time to notify the MHA members at least two weeks prior to the show that a pointed class has been added. (Rule 5, Part 1, Sec 2). Classes can be added after June 5, but will not be MHA pointed. Request classes will be scheduled as appropriate for the flow of the show.

400. \$400 4th DECADE PLEASURE HORSE STAKE

If entries warrant, classes in the hunter ring will be suspended during this class.

To be judged independently by both judges with scores combined. Placings will be announced in reverse order.

To be shown at a flat walk, trot/jog/alternate gait and canter/lope both ways of the ring. Judge may ask for extension at any gait. Must stand quietly and back readily in the line-up. To be judged on manners, performance as indicated by type, and quality as represented by discipline.

Prize Money: First, \$135; second, \$90; third, \$55; fourth, \$45; fifth, \$40; sixth, \$35
Winner to receive the **DOWNEAST SIGNATURE CHALLENGE TROPHY**

DOWNEAST TRAIL VERSATILITY CHALLENGE

A two-round competition to be shown over a minimum of 12 natural and man-made obstacles. May be shown in Western or English tack (no hybrid tack). The first round is a judged round with a score for each obstacle. After three refusals on an obstacle, rider must proceed to the next obstacle. The second round is timed with penalty time faults for refused/incomplete negotiation of an obstacle. The placings in each round will be converted to numerical scores and combined. Ties to be broken by the best judged score on a pre-determined list of obstacles. To be held Saturday morning. Juniors may cross-enter into the open class. Awards will be presented after the trail classes in the coliseum on Saturday afternoon.

ECCRA RANCH HORSE DIVISION **Not NEHC Rated/Not MHA Pointed**

Open to any professional or nonprofessional regardless of age or rider eligibility, regardless of past winnings. Must ride one handed in curb bits unless showing in a snaffle or bosal.

Shall be shown with no hoof polish; no braided or banded manes/tails or tail extensions. Trimming inside ears is discouraged.; trimming bridle path is allowed, also trimming of fetlocks or excessive (long) facial hair. Equipment with silver should not count over a good working outfit. Excessive silver on bridles and saddles is discouraged. For complete rules go to www.eccrassociation.com Six ribbons with placings to tenth for ECCRA purposes.

301. & 302. Ranch Horse in Hand

To be shown in a halter. SILVER SHOW HALTERS are discouraged. All entries will be judged at a walk, trot & extended trot. Entries will line up at the judge's direction. To be judged 60% on correctness, balance, way of moving and conformation suitable for a working ranch type horse and 40% on manners & disposition. Class will be divided in to two sections (Mares and Stallions/Geldings) if at least three entries for each section.

303. - 312. Ranch Horse Pleasure, Open

To be shown at a walk, trot, extended trot, lope and (optional) extended lope both ways of the ring. May be asked to halt from any gait, sidepass or do a 180 to reverse.

To be judged on the overall cadence and performance of the gaits with an emphasis on forward movement, free-flowing, and ground covering for all gaits. Transitions should be performed where designated, with smoothness and responsiveness. The ideal stock horse should have a natural, level headed carriage at each gait.

313. – 322. Ranch Riding

The purpose of the ranch riding class is to measure the ability of the horse to be a pleasure to ride while being used as a means of conveyance from performing one ranch task to another. The horse should reflect the versatility, attitude and movement of a working ranch horse riding outside the confines of an arena. The horse should be well trained, relaxed, quite, soft and cadenced at all gaits. The ideal ranch horse will travel with forward movement and demonstrate an obvious lengthening of stride at extended gaits. The horse can be ridden with light contact or on a relatively loose rein without requiring undue restraint, but not shown on a full drape of reins. The overall manners and responsiveness of the ranch riding horse to make timely transitions in a smooth and correct manner, as well as the

quality of the movement are of primary considerations. The ideal ranch riding horse should have a natural head carriage at each gait.

323. - 332. Ranch Horse Trail

To be shown over a course of at least six obstacles simulating situations encountered in every day riding. To be judged on the correctness, efficiency, and pattern accuracy with which the obstacles are negotiated and the attitude and mannerisms exhibited by the horse. Judging emphasis is on identifying the well-broke, responsive, well-mannered horse which can correctly navigate and negotiate the course.

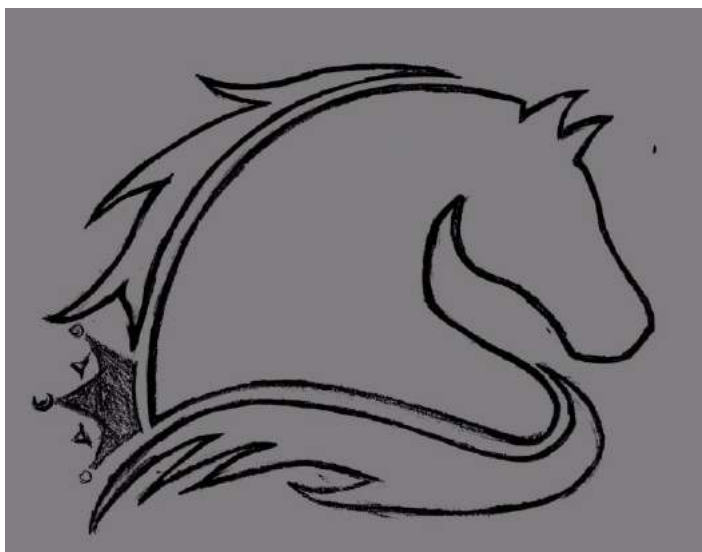
