Show Rules:

1. All classes recognized by Maine Horse Association will be conducted and judged under the current rules of MHA.
2. All classes recognized by Downeast Medal Finals will be conducted and judged under the current rules of DMF.
3. No horse/pony may enter a class unless an entry blank has been completed, fees paid, and number assigned.
4. Entry fees are as follows: \$15 per regular classes; \$20 per Stake, Medal, and Championship classes; MHA fee \$4 per horse/pony; and \$15 post entry fee per horse/pony and rider combination. Entries close 5/16/2022.
5. Food will be available on the grounds. Lunch break, if any, will be announced.
6. No refunds without note from veterinarian or medical doctor.
7. No dogs allowed on premises unless leashed and kept away from the ring.
8. In each hunter division, to be eligible for its Stake class, entry must have been entered, shown and judged in its respective 'over fences' class. For Stake/Championship classes, prerequisites for entry are listed in parentheses ().
9. Show ring/course will be an enclosed arena. A schooling area will be available outside of the course.
10. Warm-ups will be held as noted in the class list.
11. A schooling area with jumps will be provided from 8:00am through the end of the show.
12. Six ribbons per class will be awarded.
13. Medal specifications will be available at the secretary's booth.
14. Championship and Reserve Championship ribbons will be awarded based on points (no entry fee) in respective divisions. Divisions considered are leadline, walk/trot, easy does it, short stirrup, schooling hunter, special hunter, low hunter
15. Proof of current negative coggins and rabies required. Mail in with entry or bring to secretary's stand.
16. MHA Medallion Pleasure is open to members & non-members with no residency restrictions
17. Lesson/Camp Rider Walk Trot classes are not affiliated with MHA. They are open to all ages of rider riding lesson or camp horses with breeches, polo shirts, and half-chaps as acceptable attire.
18. Hemphill's class open to any horse owned by, leased from, or purchased at Hemphill's!
19. No prize money offered at this show.
