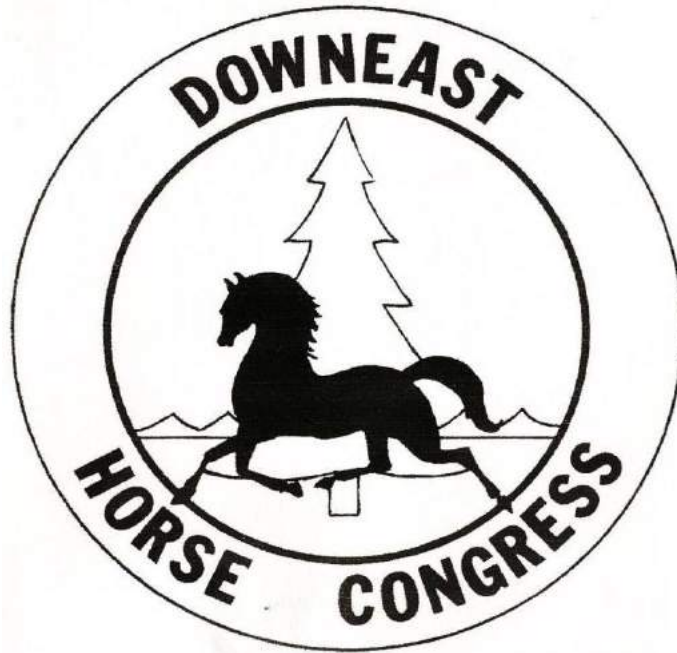

Exhibitors are expected to read these rules and not enter any horse/pony unless they are prepared to abide by these rules, the rules of MHA, NEHC, affiliated associations and this show. Show management reserves the right to refuse any entry or request the removal of any entry or person on the grounds without being liable.

Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules & Specifications of the current Rule Books of MHA, NEHC, MeHJA, TIP, USHJA will be conducted & judged in accordance with those rules. All classes MHA pointed UNLESS Noted.

Additional Payment Information:

- All fees must be paid in full (or a signed blank check left with the office to pay for all charges) before number is issued.
- \$50.00 fee will be charged for NSF checks in addition to bank fees & original charge.
- **Refunds** for classes will only be considered upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate (or doctor's certificate) and must be received by the Show Manager before the end of the show. No refunds on Stalls or campers.

CREDENTIALS - Including this information with your entries will greatly facilitate check in & number pick-up! ☺

- Vaccinations.** Please include a copy of vaccination records for your horse(s) with your entries. It is highly recommended that **all animals** on the show grounds be vaccinated for **RABIES** within one year of this show.
- Proof of Negative Coggins** within the last three years is required for horses stabled in the State of Maine and within the last six months is required for out of state horses. Please include Coggins date (month/year) on your entry blank.
- Adult Riders** in classes **restricted to Amateurs** must have a valid amateur card from USEF, NEHC or MHA available for inspection. MHA and NEHC Amateur cards may be applied for at the Show.
- Registration Papers** are required for entries in classes restricted to a registered breed. Please include registration number(s) on your entry blank and include a copy of the papers with your entry form. **Saddlebred exhibitors** MUST also provide their ASHA membership numbers for owner, rider, driver & handler.
- USHJA Outreach** - To be eligible for USHJA Outreach points and year-end awards, riders must be a USHJA member (Outreach level or higher). Horses wishing to accrue points toward year-end Outreach awards must be registered with USHJA and microchipped. USHJA Horse registrations are available for \$20/annual or \$75/lifetime.

General Information:

1. **Adds/Scratches** for the **Coliseum** MUST be made the session before at the Office, please be sure that the paperwork for adds/scratches has been delivered to the Main Office.
2. **Entries for Friday** MUST be made by Thursday Your compliance helps the show start promptly and is greatly appreciated. **Holds** by permission of Show Management only. Forms are available in the office.
3. **Food** will be available on the grounds.
4. **Length of Breaks** will be announced.
5. Six ribbons in all classes. Prize Money indicated in class title with trophy in all other classes.
6. **Prize Money** will be directly credited to your show bill. Checks for additional award money will be issued only after show bill has been paid in full.
7. **Prize Money** distributed as follows:
 \$50 – \$20, \$15, \$10, \$5; first through fourth, respectively
 \$75 --\$30. \$20, \$15, \$10, first through fourth, respectively
 Special class monies listed with class descriptions.
8. Arena lights will be turned off at 10:00 pm or after the show
9. **For everyone's safety** ~
 No **strollers** in the chute area and near the in/out gate.
 All **dogs** must be tied or on a leash & kept away from the show ring rail.
 Lunging and long lining are NOT allowed in the coliseum.
 Bicycles & scooters allowed only in the camping area behind last barn.
 Fire & Emergency lanes must be kept open at all times
10. Any person entering the ring while the show is in progress must be properly attired. No short-shorts/skirts, tank tops, torn/worn clothing. Items with stable logos are not permitted.
11. Exhibitors wishing to speak to the judge after their last class must obtain permission of the Manager and Steward & will be allowed only if it does not delay the show.
12. **WARNING Under Maine Law an equine professional has limited liability for an injury or death resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.**
13. All Championship/Stake classes: To be eligible, respective horse/rider must have been entered, shown and judged in at least one class listed in parenthesis in the Classes by Division section.
14. **ALL JUNIOR EXHIBITOR Hunter Seat Riders** and **ALL HUNTER/JUMPING SEAT EQUITATION AND HUNTER PLEASURE EQUITATION RIDERS, REGARDLESS OF AGE, IN ALL SHOWS ARE REQUIRED** are required to wear ASTM/SEI approved protective properly fastened headgear when mounted (Exception: Juniors in Morgan Hunter Pleasure). **ANY RIDER violating headgear rules** at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with such standards. Riders of ALL seats are encouraged to wear ASTM/SEI approved headgear and shall not be penalized for doing so.
15. **REQUEST CLASS(ES)** are available for a \$20 Sponsor Fee (plus your class entry fee). Requests made prior to June 6th will count for MHA/NEHC points. Requests after that will not.

➔ **PLEASURE EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE:** During the hunter ring sessions on Saturday and Sunday afternoons, there will be specified warm-up areas for the hunters/jumpers (roughly the approach to the ring from the swine barn to the ring and the other side of the show office across to the covered area and toward the ring). **EVERYONE** (regardless of seat), riding in these areas during the hunter sessions is **REQUIRED** to wear a properly secured helmet which meets/exceeds ASTM/SEI standards. Other areas of the horse show area (beyond barn one and toward the camping area) are available as usual to work pleasure ring entries. Thank you for helping us with this detail.

"Every entry at an affiliated event shall constitute an agreement that the person making it, owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider and the horse Shall be subject to the Bylaws, and the Rules of the Association, the rules and regulations of the show, and that every horse, rider and/or driver is eligible as entered and that the owner and any of his representatives are bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Maine Horse Association, Inc., the New England Horsemen's Council, Inc., and the affiliated event, accept as final the decision of the MHA, Inc, the NEHC, Inc, or committees thereof in any question arising under said rules, and agree to hold the affiliated event, the Downeast Horse Congress Horse Show, the MHA Inc, the NEHC, Inc, their respective officials, directors and employees, harmless for any action taken, or for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with the show, whether or not such injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly from the negligent actor omissions of said officials, directors, employees or agents of MHA, Inc, NEHC, Inc., or Downeast Horse Congress Horse Show. The constitution or application of MHA, Inc. rules is governed by the Laws of the State of Maine."
