

Show management reserves the right to refuse any entry or request the removal of any entry or person on the grounds without being liable.

Every class offered herein which is covered by the Rules & Specifications of the current Rule Books of MHA, NEHC, MeHJA, TIP, USHJA will be conducted & judged in accordance with those rules. All classes MHA pointed UNLESS noted.

Additional Payment Information:

- All fees must be paid in full (or a signed blank check left with the office to pay for all charges) before number is issued.
- \$50.00 fee will be charged for NSF checks in addition to bank fees & original charge.
- Refunds for classes will only be considered upon receipt of a veterinarian's certificate (or doctor's certificate) and must be received by the Show Manager before the end of the show. No refunds on Stalls or campers.

CREDENTIALS - Including this information with your entries will greatly facilitate check in & number pick-up!

- A. Vaccinations. Please include a copy of <u>vaccination records for your horse(s)</u> with your entries. It is highly recommended that all animals on the show grounds be vaccinated for RABIES within one year of this show.
- B. **Proof of Negative Coggins** within the last three years is required for horses stabled in the State of Maine and within the last six months is required for out of state horses. Please include Coggins date (month/year) on your entry blank.
- C. Adult Riders in classes restricted to Amateurs must have <u>a valid amateur card</u> from USEF, NEHC or MHA available for inspection. MHA and NEHC Amateur cards may be applied for at the Show.

- D. Registration Papers are required for entries in classes restricted to a registered breed. Please include registration number(s) on your entry blank and include a copy of the papers with your entry form. Saddlebred exhibitors MUST also provide their ASHA membership numbers for owner, rider, driver & handler.
- E. USHJA Outreach To be eligible for USHJA Outreach points and year-end awards, riders must be a USHJA member (Outreach level or higher). Horses wishing to accrue points toward year-end Outreach awards must be registered with USHJA and microchipped. USHJA Horse registrations are available for \$20/annual or \$75/lifetime.

General Information

- 1. Every class recognized by the Maine Horse Association will be conducted and judged under the current rules of the Maine Horse Association.
- 2. Every class recognized by the New England Horseman's Council will be conducted and judged under the current rules of the New England Horseman's Council
- 3. Adds/Scratches for the Coliseum MUST be made the session before at the Office, please be sure that the paperwork for adds/scratches has been delivered to the Main Office.
- 4. **Entries for Friday** MUST be made by Thursday Your compliance helps the show start promptly and is greatly appreciated. **Holds** by permission of Show Management only. Forms are available in the office.
- 5. **Food** will be available on the grounds.
- 6. Length of Breaks will be announced.
- 7. Six ribbons in all classes. Prize Money indicated in class title with trophy in all other classes.
- 8. **Prize Money** will be directly credited to your show bill. Checks for award money will be issued only after show bill has been paid in full.
- 9. **Prize Money** distributed as follows:
 - \$100 \$50, \$25, \$15, \$10; first through fourth, respectively
- 10. Arena lights will be turned off at 10:00 pm or after the show
- 11. For everyone's safety ~~
 - No **strollers** in the chute area and near the in/out gate.
 - All **dogs** must be tied or on a leash & kept away from the show ring rail.
 - Lunging and long lining are NOT allowed in the coliseum.
 - Bicycles & scooters allowed only in the camping area behind last barn.
 - Fire & Emergency lanes must be kept open at all times
- 12. Any person entering the ring while the show is in progress must be properly attired. No short-shorts/skirts, tank tops, torn/worn clothing. Items with stable logos are not permitted.
- 13. Exhibitors wishing to speak to the judge after their last class must obtain permission of the Manager and Steward & will be allowed only if it does not delay the show.
- 14. WARNING Under Maine Law an equine professional has limited liability for an injury or death resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.
- 15. All Championship/Stake classes: To be eligible, respective horse/rider must have been entered, shown and judged in at least one class listed in parenthesis in the Classes by Division section.
- 16. <u>ALL JUNIOR EXHIBITOR Hunter Seat Riders</u> are required to wear ASTM/SEI approved protective properly fastened headgear when mounted (Exception: Juniors in Morgan Hunter Pleasure). Riders of ALL seats are encouraged to wear ASTM/SEI approved headgear and shall not be penalized for doing so.

15. ALL HUNTER/JUMPING SEAT EQUITATION AND HUNTER PLEASURE EQUITATION RIDERS, REGARDLESS OF AGE, IN ALL SHOWS ARE REQUIRED to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM/SEI standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. This INCLUDES Equitation Classes open to ALL seats. ANY RIDER violating headgear rules at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with such standards.

To be shown in a Halter. All entries will be judged at a walk, trot and extended trot. To be judged 60% on correctness, balance, way of moving and confirmation suitable for a ranch type horse and 40% on manners and disposition.

80 Ranch Horse Pleasure Class

The ideal Ranch Horse will will travel with forward movement and be well-trained, relaxed, quiet, and soft at all gaits. Horse should be ridden on a relatively loose rein with light contact. The horse should be soft in the bridle and yield to contact.

- 88 Walk Trot Ranch Pleasure
- 32 Ranch Riding.

The Ranch horse should well-trained, relaxed, quiet, soft, and cadenced at all gaits. The ideal Ranch Horse will travel with forward movement and demonstrate an obvious lengthening 0f stride at extended gaits. They should be ridden on light contact on a relatively loose rein. The overall manners and responsiveness of the horse to make timely transitions in a smooth and correct manner as well as quality of movement are primary considerations.

- 55 Ranch Riding Walk / Trot
- 72 Ranch Horse Trail

This class tests the horses ability to cope with everyday situations. The horse/rider team is judged on the correctness, efficiency, and pattern accuracy with which the obstacles are negotiated and the attitude and mannerisms exhibited by the horse. Judging emphasis is on identifying the well broke, responsive, well mannered horse which can correctly navigate the trail course.
