## Show Rules:

1. All classes recognized by Maine Horse Association will be conducted and judged under the current rules of MHA, except those classes recognized only by Maine Hunter/Jumper Association which will be conducted and judged under the current rules of MeHJA.
2. All classes recognized by the Thoroughbred Incentive Program will be conducted and judged under the current rules of TIP. For TIP purposes, classes 54, 55, and 56 shall be considered The Jockey Club TIP Special Thoroughbred Hunter Division.
3. All Downeast Medal Finals classes will be conducted and judged under the current rules of DMF.
4. USHJA Outreach - To be eligible for USHJA Outreach points and year-end awards, riders must be a USHJA member (Outreach level or higher). Horses wishing to accrue points toward year-end Outreach awards must be registered with USHJA and microchipped. USHJA Horse registrations are available for \$20/annual or \$75/lifetime.
5. No horse/pony may enter a class unless an entry blank has been completed, fees paid, and number assigned.
6. Entry fees are as follows: \$15 per regular classes; \$20 per Stake, Medal, and Championship classes; MHA fee \$4 per horse/pony; Outreach fee \$5 per horse/pony; Un-Judged Warm-Up \$10 per round; and \$15 post-entry fee per horse/pony and rider combination. **Pre-entries close 8/3/25.**
7. Food will be available on the grounds. Lunch break, if any, will be announced.
8. No refunds without note from veterinarian or medical doctor.
9. No dogs allowed on premises unless leashed and kept away from the ring.
10. In each hunter division, to be eligible for its Stake class, entry must have been entered, shown and judged in its respective 'over fences' class. For Stake/Championship classes, prerequisites are in parentheses ( ).
11. Show ring/course will be an enclosed sand ring. A schooling area will be available outside of the course.
12. Warm-ups will be held after classes 23, 38, 50, and 58. Warm ups are 1 round per ticket. Jumping order will be used and one horse may be in the ring per time.
13. A schooling area with jumps will be provided from 8:00 am through the end of the show. Course walks are allowed between 8:00 and 9:00.
14. Six ribbons per class will be awarded.
15. Medal specifications will be available at the secretary's booth.
16. Championship and Reserve Championship ribbons will be awarded based on points (no entry fee) in respective divisions. Divisions considered are Puddle Jumpers, Schooling Jumpers, Short Stirrup Hunter, Easy Does It Hunter, Pre-Green Hunter, Schooling Hunter, Special Working Hunter, Thoroughbred Hunter (TIP Special Thoroughbred Hunter), and Low Working Hunter. Thoroughbred Incentive Program (TIP) High Point Hunter, High Point Jumper, High Point English Pleasure Thoroughbred, and High Point Thoroughbred (all divisions/disciplines) will be awarded. High Point and Reserve Pony Clubber will also be awarded for Current Pony Club Members and Pony Club Alumni.
17. Proof of current negative coggins and rabies required. Mail in with entry or bring to secretary's stand.
18. Cross country courses and jumps are closed to all horses.
